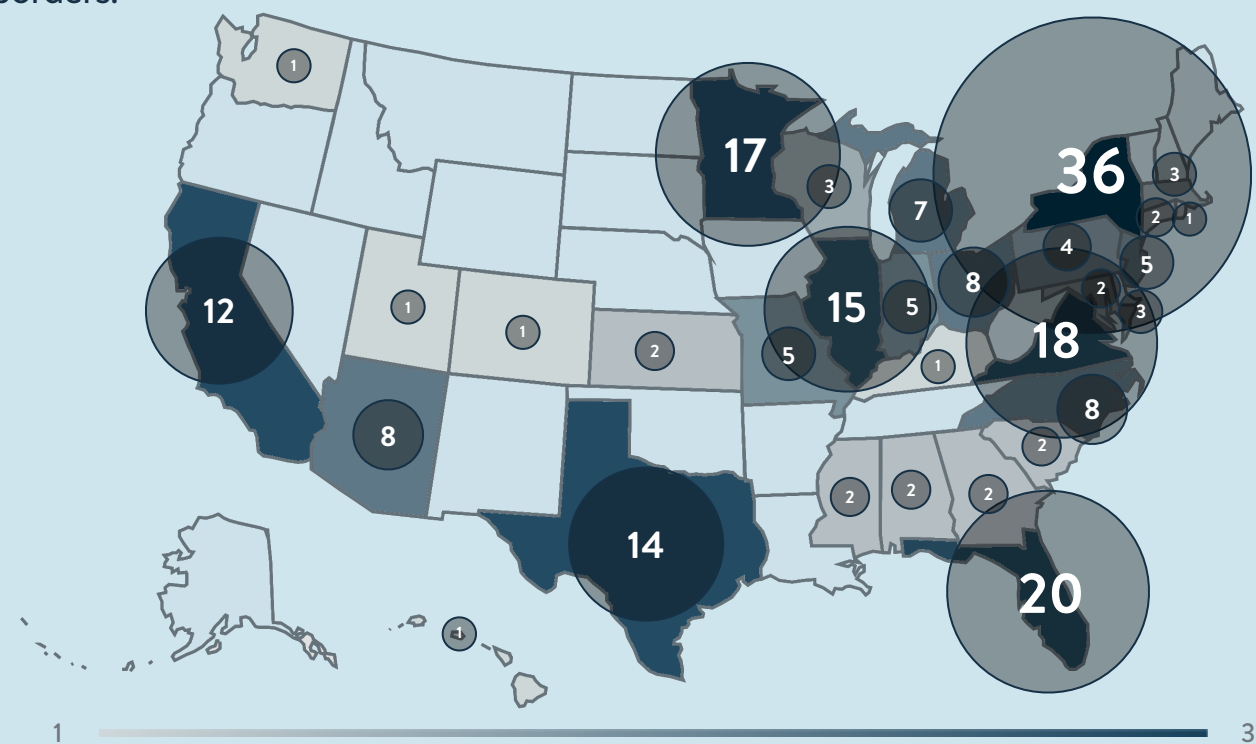
217 individuals have been charged in the U.S.

(As of November 1, 2020)

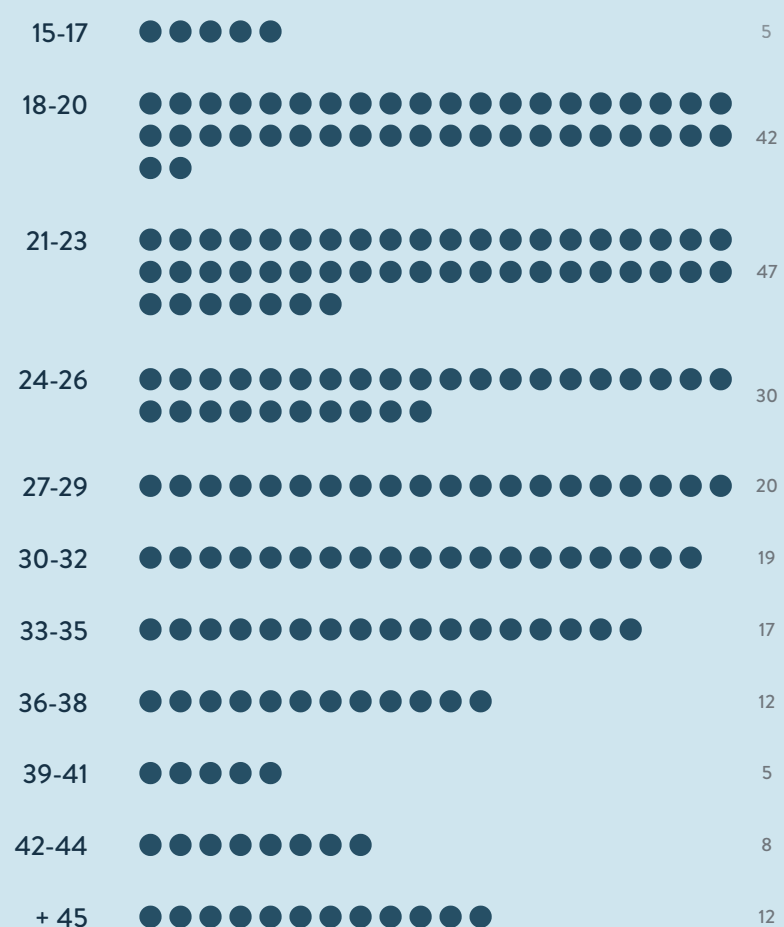
NUMBERS BY STATE

The FBI has stated that there are active IS-related investigations in all 50 states. To date, 30 states and the District of Columbia have had at least one charge within their borders.
