

HASHER JALLAL TAHEB





Hasher Jallal Taheb, a 23-year-old resident of Cumming, Georgia, pleaded guilty in the Northern District of Georgia to attempting to destroy, by fire or an explosive, a building owned by or leased to the United States. Taheb began planning a domestic terror attack in October 2018 after foregoing his initial plans to travel overseas to join IS, and ultimately decided to attempt to conduct an attack on the White House with explosives. Taheb arranged, with an FBI undercover employee, to use semiautomatic weapons, IEDs, an anti-tank weapon, and hand grenades in the planned attack.
